## POST-VISIT ACTIVITIES – FOOD AND FARMING

Draw a picture of a fallow deer and label its body parts and adaptations.

Make a snack using some of ingredients which Holkham grow on the farm.

Make a poster to advertise one of the products Holkham makes e.g. Maltesers.

Write a newspaper article on why we should eat British food.

Make a presentation about Thomas William Coke.

Make a food web showing birds of prey and pheasants.

Make a calendar showing what jobs need doing on the farm each month e.g. drilling spring barley in March, planting potatoes April, cereals harvest August etc

Grow potatoes in a grow bag or tyres at school.

Compare the difference between sheep and cows as grazing animals.

Explain why bees are so important and what Holkham does to help them.

Explain why soil is so valuable to farmers and how they can help it.

Visit another local farm to see how it's different to Holkham.

Make a machinery catalogue explaining what machinery does which task e.g. Combine Harvester, Tractor, Plough, Baler.

Write a newspaper/internet job advert for different jobs on the farm e.g. Farm Manager, Tractor Driver, Agronomist.
