A potted history...

In 1712, a young Thomas Coke, who later became the 1st Earl of Leicester, set out on what was to become an incredible six year long Grand Tour. Spending much of this time in Italy, Thomas met William Kent and together they developed a passion for the architecture of Andrea Palladio, who championed a return to the building styles of Ancient Rome. Thomas collected paintings, sculptures, drawings, manuscripts and treasures galore on his travels. When he returned to England, he turned his dreams into reality by planning the building of a vast Palladian house on the North Norfolk coast, and created the magnificent Holkham Hall.
